

MAJOR CATEGORIES OF REFRIGERATION EQUIPMENT AFFECTED BY THE REFRIGERANT RECYCLING RULE

Chapter XXX, page 8

1. ***Household Refrigeration.*** Refrigerators and freezers intended primarily for household use, though they may be used outside the home (e.g., in offices, etc.).
2. ***Transportation Refrigeration.*** Refrigerated ship holds; truck trailers; railway freight cars; other shipping containers.
3. ***Commercial Comfort Air Conditioning.*** Centrifugal chillers; reciprocating chillers; screw chillers.
4. ***Comfort Cooling in Vehicles (Other than Trucks and Autos).*** Trains; airplanes; ships; buses; farm equipment; construction equipment.
5. ***Other Refrigerated Appliances.*** Dehumidifiers; vending machines; ice makers; water coolers.
6. ***Residential Air Conditioning.*** Window units; packaged terminal air conditioners; central air conditioners; light commercial air conditioners; heat pumps.
7. ***Retail Food.*** Small reach-in refrigerators and freezers; refrigerated display cases; walk-in coolers and freezers; large parallel rack systems. (Includes equipment found in supermarkets, convenience stores, restaurants, and other food service operations).
8. ***Cold Storage Warehouses.***
9. ***Commercial Comfort Air Conditioning.***
10. ***Industrial Process Refrigeration.*** Includes but is not limited to industrial ice machines and ice rinks.
11. ***Military Equipment.*** The final rule does not apply to devices containing and using refrigerants that are designed for and used solely in a military application. Such devices are excepted unless their system of parts in that equipment is identical to equipment used for household or commercial purposes.
