

## **Southwest Asia Teleconference, August 20, 2003**

### **Agenda:**

#### **Update from PSAB closure team. Identify any outstanding issues.**

The PSAB DCST team completed destruction of the final piece of military equipment at PSAB requiring de-militarization, by melting an Armored Personnel Carrier on Saturday August 16, 2003. A de-militarization certificate was completed and digital photos were forwarded to DRMS and DLA. The physical security of the DRMO yard was reinforced through placement of additional concertina wire, and additional concrete barriers.

On Monday August 18, 2003 The 363d AEW Commander and Vice Commander toured the DRMO yard, and thanked the DRMS team for their work at PSAB. CDR McGrath signed a memorandum transferring the DRMO yard inventory to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Lt.Col. Pandes will hold the memo until he obtains a signature from COL Maymoon of the RSAF as a representative of the KSA, and the USAF is ready to leave PSAB. Lt.Col. Pandes will scan and e-mail a signed copy of the memo to CDR McGrath once signature is obtained. Lt.Col. Fisher at the Friendly Forces Coordination Cell in Riyadh will follow up with the Ministry of Defense and Aviation for the signed acknowledgement letter regarding the DRMO property donation. A scanned signed copy will be forwarded to DRMS as soon as it is available. The DRMS team has completed all required actions at PSAB and is scheduled to travel to Kuwait via military air.

#### **GAO visit to SWA**

LtCol Goldsack is preparing a briefing to present to the GAO team on Thurs, the 21<sup>st</sup>. Bryan Russell prepared a brief to be presented by CDR McGrath upon GAO's (Sept 26- Oct 11) arrival in theater. At this point, it has been decided that we will not send anyone from HQ to SWA for the GAO visit. It was suggested that the GAO be invited to participate in one of the teleconferences during their visit to SWA so DRMSI-HQ and FST could provide any additional information they may need.

**Other issues:** DRMS-ILA will get with Central Europe ZM to begin putting together a one time sale catalog for the approx 800,000 – 1,000,000 pounds of brass and steel located in Kuwait.

The customer in Oman with a small quantity of brass will be advised to ship it to the holding area at Camp Arifjan, Kuwait. The catalog will reflect two sites for pickup to accommodate the removal of the brass.

Dennis Baxter will provide information to contracting in Weisbaden so a task order can be issued on the auctioneering contract. The task order will request that the contractor translate and market the catalog prepared by DRMO K-town for the M-series vehicles and tank track, sprockets and road wheels.

Dennis Baxter will coordinate the removal of some chaff located at SEEB with Woody.

The final HW removal at Saudi is still scheduled for 25 Aug

Woody will go to Kuwait to process the sale of the property at Camp Doha. Roscoe Davis will assist with the sale.

Nicer Hassan and Woody departed from Kuwait today.
